



#### REPORT

The short term course programmeon**Direct Composite Veneering & Aesthetic Management of Ellis Class II Fracture of Anterior Teeth**was held from 16 August 2023 to 22August 2023 for 6 days organized by the faculty of Dental Sciences. The programme was started in an offline mode. A total of 15 participants were registered for the programme. Course duration 30 hours (5 hours everyday for 6 days). The objective of the programme is to prepare the candidate to manage the discoloured tooth, tooth affected with enamel hypoplasia or fluorosis and clinical management of Ellis class II fractured tooth and restoring it with composite material.

Learning objectives of course:-

- 1. To learn how to re-establish a patient's lost dental esthetic appearance due to existing malformations, esthetic deficiencies and discolouration,
- 2. To gain both theoretical and clinical knowledge about managing Ellis class II fracture

Dr Arun Sharma (Prof and Head) took the theory class on Composite veneering and Ellis Class II fractures on Day 1. Dr Karuna Sharma(Reader) gave the demonstration of tooth preparation to receive composite veneer on Day 1 and placement of composite on tooth and then final finishing and polishing of composite veneering on Day 2 to all the students. Dr Arun Sharma (Prof and Head)demonstrated the tooth preparation to restore the class II fractured tooth to the participants. All the fourteen students did composite veneering and Ellis class II fracture restoration on 3 typhodont teeth for each procedure Finally all the students were evaluated by the Instructors of the course and were graded accordingly and theory marks were given according to their performance in Multiple choice Question paper.
