

Short Term Course Report on Implants (Aug 2023)

Short term course on implants wasconducted by the department of oral and maxillofacial surgery from 9/8/2023 to 14/8/2023. The program was held in off line mode. Around 20 participants registered for the course comprising of both students from Rama university as well as from other colleges. Total duration of the course was 30 hours which were distributed over 5 days from 9am to 4pm. The course began with lectures on day 1& 2 followed by demonstrations for implant placements on dummy (Day 1) as well as live demonstration of implant placement on patients(Day 3& 4). Students had hands on implant placements on dummy jaw sets (Day 3,4 & 5).

The schedule for the course was as follows:
