





REPORT OF THE BOARD OF STUDIES MEETING HELD ON 15/07/2022 AT 11:30AM





Course description: Faculty of Nursing is now accepting application for its short term course on hospital infection control practices: PPE, hand-washing & BMW management for session 2021-22

Course overview: Infection is one of the most dreaded adverse events associated with healthcare delivery, accounting for considerable morbidity, mortality and cost. This course offers a unique title in field of health care i.e. infection control practices. This is a guide for health care workers involved in patient care activities in a health care setting. This course has been specially tailored for skill building of staff on initial assessment of hospital acquired infection occurring in the hospital measuring and evaluating quality indicators related to infection control practices, actively contributing towards prevention of infection, reducing the incidences in critical care areas and executing quality assurance practices in the health care system.

Poor infection control practices and untrained infection prevention staff create an unhealthy imbalance between the care provided and the outcome of the treatment. Here originates the need for in depth training, according to optimum standards and professional accountability that encourages health care organizations to pursue continual excellence.

The objective of this program is an endeavor to prepare healthcare professionals for implementation of hospital infection control activities in their daily practices to prevent hospital acquired infections.

The course/training programme may be organized by the faculty of nursing. The programme should be self-financing (Funds should be raised through registration fees from Participants). The funds raised shall be deposited into the college accounts and operated by Principal investigator or co-investigator.

1. **Course title:-** Hospital Infection control practices: PPE, hand-washing & BMW management
2. **Proposed month:-** July to September- 2022
3. **Learning objectives of course:-** At the end of this course the participants will be able to:-
 - Discuss about the health care associated infections & infection control policies
 - Discuss the current perspective of infection control.

- Describe about the infection transmission process & its prevention
- Describe about the physical and chemical methods of sterilization and disinfection
- Describe about the various methods used in cleaning & disinfection of medical equipment.
- Discuss about the different types of (PPE) Personal protective equipment helps in prevention of transmission of infection;
- Understand about the different type of hand washing and their significances in hospital setting
- Understand about the role of hand hygiene in control of hospital acquired infection.
- Discuss about the aspect related to standard norms, principles, classification, sources & hazards associated with biomedical waste management.
- Understand about the treatment and disposal techniques of bio medical waste management.
- Apply the knowledge and skills necessary in improving protection from communicable diseases.

4. Eligibility criteria for admission: -

- All nurses working in government or private hospitals are eligible for the course.
- Working students
- Any other interested health care workers involved directly or indirectly with infection control practices may also eligible for the course.
- Minimum 17 & maximum age no bar

5. Medium of instruction: - English

6. Mode of instruction: - Classroom/online mode/practical training

7. Enrolment: - This programme will start with minimum 20 participants and there is no maximum limit for enrollment. Interested candidate can approach to programme investigator for more information (given on last page)

8. Course duration: - 40 Hours- (Th-30 & Pr-10 hours), 4 hrs./week

9. Registration/course fees: - 1000

10. Courseware: - Course material is provided in printed/ electronic form

11. Certification: - At the end of programme the student will be awarded a certificate of course completion.

This course offers a unique title in field of health care setting i.e. infection control practices. This is a guide for health care workers involved in patient care activities in a health care setting. This course has been specially tailored for skill building of a nurse on initial assessment of hospital acquired infection occurring in the hospital measuring and evaluating quality indicators related to infection control practices, actively contributing towards prevention of infection, reducing the incidences in critical care areas and executing quality assurance practices in the health care system.

Poor infection control practices and untrained infection prevention staff create an unhealthy imbalance between the care provided and the outcome of the treatment. Here originates the need for in depth training, according to optimum standards and professional accountability that encourages health care organizations to pursue continual excellence.

In relation to the level of knowledge on Short-term course among participants, the Pretest results shows that 1(3 %) participants scored "B+" grade, 2(7%) scored "B+" grade, 3 (10 %) participants scored "B" grade, 11(35 %) participants scored "C" grade, 9(29 %) scored "D" grade, and 5 (16 %) participants scored "F" grade. While in the post test, the knowledge level improved as 16 (52 %) participants scored "O" grade, 14(45 %) scored "A+" grade, 1 (3 %) of participants scored "A+" grade, and there was no participants in B+, B, C and D grades. The results indicate that participants level of knowledge on Short-term course has increased and participants has benefited from the programme


