In relation to the level of knowledge on Short-term courseamong participants, the Pretest results shows that 1(3 %) participants scored2(7%) scored "B+" grade, 3 (10 %) participants scored "B" grade, 11(35 %) participants scored "C" grade, 9(29 %)scored"D" grade, and 5 (16 %)participants scored "F" grade. While in the post test, the knowledge level improved as 16 (52 %)participants scored "O" grade, 14(45 %) scored "A+" grade, 1 (3 %) of participants scored "A+" grade, and there was no participants in B+, B, C and D grades. The results indicate that participants level of knowledge on Short-term coursehas increased and participants has benefited from the programme
