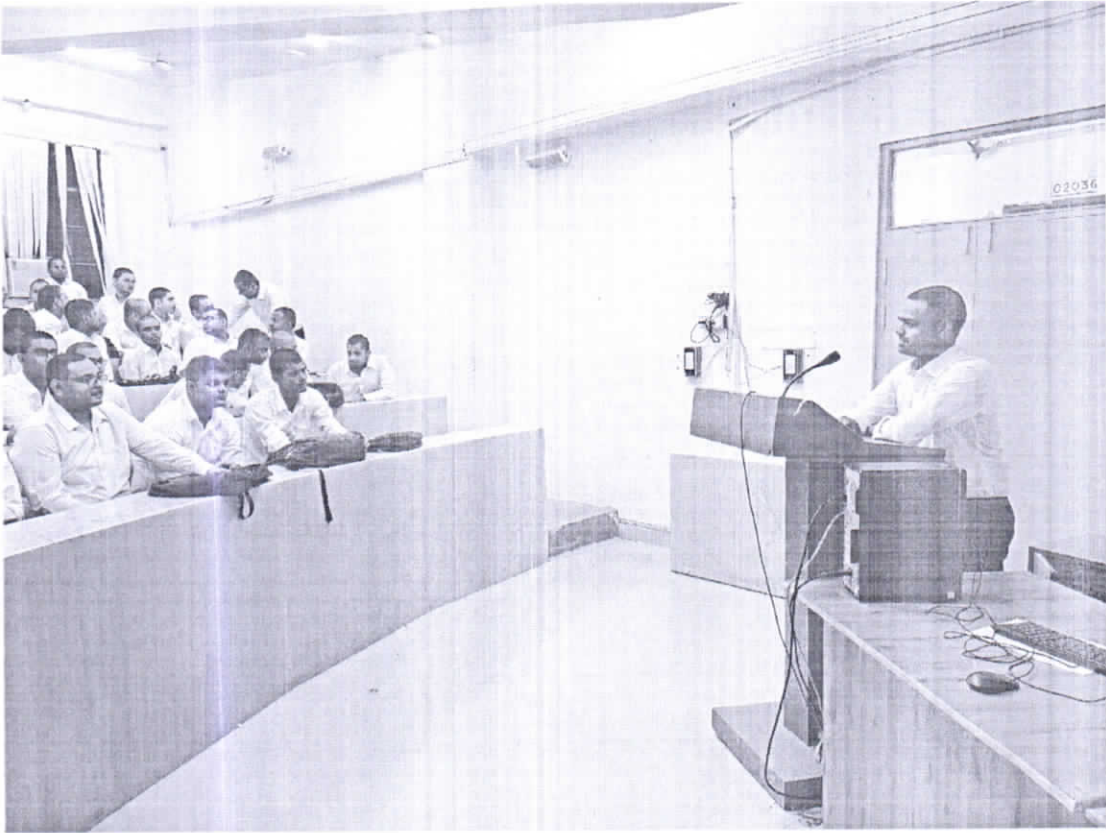
Outcomes
